II--AWARD OF SILVER STAR (OAK LEAF CLUSTER) -- Under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, the bronze Oak Leaf Cluster for wear with the Silver Star previously awarded, is awarded to the following officer and enlisted man:

First Lieutenant Alwyn D. Conger, 0887446, Field Artillery, 113th Field Artillery Battalion, United States Army, for gallantry in action on 21 February 1945, in Germany. Lieutenant Conger remained at his observation post despite constant enemy shelling in an effort to locate enemy artillery positions. The information he relayed to his own unit enabled them to neutralize the enemy positions. His staunch courage and disregard for his safety reflect great credit upon himself and the Armed Forces. Entered military service from Washington.
